8. CONTESTANTS

- 8.1 Membership Participants must hold a valid BTCB licence or be a member of a National Federation which is affiliated to the WTF.
- 8.2 Divisions
- A – Class: 1st Dan / Poom and higher
 - B – Class: 1st Kup (Black tag) – 4th Kup (Blue belt)
 - C – Class: 5th Kup (Blue tag) – 9th Kup (Yellow tag)

9. A – CLASS DIVISION (DAN / POOM GRADES)

9.1 A – Class:

- Full WTF Rules
- Competitors must be minimum 1st Dan / Poom grade & Kukkiwon holder.

9.2 Cut-Off System will be as follows:

- **1st Round:** If there are over 18 competitors in a division then they will start in this round.
- **2nd Round:** The top 50% of the competitors (9-18 competitors) with the highest scores from the 1st round will qualify for this 2nd round (including competitors with equal scores) (possibility for extra rounds in case of equal scores to qualify for the finals)
- **Final:** The top 6 competitors (with the highest scores) from the 2nd round will qualify for this round. Divisions may start in the final if there are 8 entrants or less. 9 entrants or more will start in the 2nd Round.

1st Round – will be two poomsae from the 1st Compulsory section of the table.

2nd Round – will be two poomsae from the 2nd Compulsory section of the table.

Final Round: Two poomsae will be required and may be performed with a one minute rest period in between. The two poomsae for the final will be the two poomsae remaining in the 2nd compulsory section.

All competitors must perform the set poomsae and if they cannot, they will be disqualified.

All poomsae will be chosen, set and announced by the organising committee 3 days before the competition (Wednesday 5th May 2010 at www.mkutachampionships.co.uk and www.utatkd.co.uk. We will also endeavour to email all participating teams and competitors.

- Judges / Referees:** Invitations shall be made by the BTCB Poomsae Judges Director to all judges who have passed the BTCB Poomsae Judges Course or similar coaching course of a WTF Affiliated body. Please contact us if you would be interested in judging at the event.
- All judges who participate will receive a free lunch and refreshments.
- It is our request that all judges dress in appropriate attire (shirt and tie etc.) in accordance with BTCB / UTA regulations.
- The organisers shall try to ensure that regular breaks and rotation of judges is provided for all judges and referees.
- Protest:** Only the official head coach is allowed to protest to the Competition Director. This must be made within 10 minutes of the end of the contest. A protest fee of £75 GBP will be payable immediately to the competition board. This will be refunded if the protest is accepted and won.
- Liability:** All competitors are considered to participate at their own risk. Neither the organisers, The UTA or the BTCB shall accept No responsibility for any damage, injuries or losses sustained or incurred.
